Foreign Student Scholarship Application Guidelines

Amended and Approved at the Fourth Meeting of the Administrative Council on May 29, 2005

Amended and Approved at the Sixth Meeting of the Administrative Council on May 14, 2015

- I. Shih Hsin University established the “Shih Hsin University Foreign Student Scholarship” in accordance with the “Ministry of Education Guidelines for the Award of Scholarships to Foreign Students” to encourage outstanding foreign students enrolled at the University to apply for the scholarship.
- II. Scholarship Amount and Disbursement:
Scholarship quotas will be specified on a yearly basis and depend on the Ministry of Education's annual budget.
- III. Eligibility:
Foreign students enrolled at Shih Hsin University as a full-time student only.
 1. Undergraduate students who have completed at least one semester of study and are currently enrolled at the University must be enrolled in and completed the minimum required credits every semester. Applicants must achieve an average grade score of seventy-five points or above in the previous semester and have not been convicted of major violations.
 2. Graduate students who have completed at least one semester of study and are currently enrolled at the University. Master’s students must be enrolled in at least two courses every semester. Doctoral students must be enrolled in at least one course every semester. Applicants must achieve an average grade score of eighty points or above in the previous semester and have not been convicted of major violations.
 3. The maximum award periods will be four years for undergraduate students, two years for master’s students, and three years for doctoral students, respectively.
 4. Applicants awarded scholarships by other government agencies or have tuition reimbursement, are excluded from this scholarship.

IV. Application Documents:

1. Application form.
2. Transcript of the previous semester.
3. Other references related to academic achievement.

V. Application Period:

Applicants should apply the scholarship according to the bulletin details which Office of Public Affairs declares in May every year.

VI. Judging Procedures:

1. Qualification Screening: Applications shall be received by the Office of Public Affairs for processing and preliminary screening.
2. Judging Committee: The Committee will consist of the Dean of Public Affairs and the Deans from relevant Colleges. The list of recipients will be approved by the University President.

VII. These guidelines and future revisions shall be approved by Administrative Council and become effective on the day of promulgation by the University President.
